The Professional Poster Programme is an opportunity for you to present your research results to a diverse group of scientific professionals who are actively involved in the discovery, development, and life cycle management of pharmaceuticals, biotechnology, medical devices, and healthcare related products.

GENERAL SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Abstracts must be submitted through the DIA website (www.diahome.org) by 8 January 2013
- Abstracts may not refer to specific brand names, products or services and be limited to generic names, including poster titles and or handouts.
- All poster presentations must be non-commercial and scientific in nature and may not be used as a marketing opportunity.
- Posters must include data, i.e., research results and conclusion for consideration
- Submissions must include complete contact information
- If an abstract is accepted, one author must attend the EuroMeeting 2013 to present the abstract
- Abstracts will be reviewed and authors notified of results the week of 14 January 2013

CALL FOR PROFESSIONAL POSTER ABSTRACTS

Submission Deadline: 8 January 2013

A maximum of 40 abstracts from full-time professionals will be selected for the professional poster session at the 25th Annual EuroMeeting and displayed at the RAI during the conference.

Selected professional poster presenters will be required to pay the applicable meeting registration fee and will be responsible for all other meeting expenses.

ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

All poster abstracts must be received by 8 January 2013

- Abstracts may not refer to specific brand names
- Abstracts should follow a structured format including all of the following:

objectives, methods, results, conclusions

- Submissions must include complete contact information
- Abstracts will be reviewed and authors notified of results the week of 14 January 2013

Presenters must prepare a poster to fit a poster board (size 147 cm x 97 cm) or portrait (size 97 cm x 147 cm), see below graphic.

Abstract Title* (Maximum 125 characters including spaces) Titles should briefly describe the focus of the abstract as well as accurately reflect the content of the abstract.

Objective* (Maximum 300 Characters including spaces) Please provide a one sentence statement of the objective of the abstract.

Method* (Maximum 300 characters including spaces) When, where, and how was the study was done? What materials were used or who was included in the study ?

Results* (Maximum 2000 characters including spaces) What quantitative data was collected? What answer was found to the research question? What did the study find? Was the tested hypothesis true?

Conclusion* (Maximum 2000 characters including spaces) What can be concluded from the study and its implications?

Abstracts will be reviewed, and authors will be notified of results no later than 14 January 2013.
