

DIA YOUNG PROFESSIONAL FELLOWSHIP

The Drug Information Association in Europe promotes the participation of young professionals in the annual EuroMeeting by offering up to 15 complimentary registrations for professionals under the age of 30.

The main objectives of this programme are to create a platform to:

- increase the involvement of young professionals in the annual DIA EuroMeeting
- stimulate mutual understanding and cross-culture co-operation
- allow knowledge acquisition and training for young professionals

The long-term goal of the programme is to develop sustainable participation of young professionals in future DIA EuroMeetings, to facilitate programme development with the help of an enlarged pool of young professionals identified as volunteers and potential speakers, and to enhance awareness of DIA meetings.

This Fellowship will allow young professionals in Europe to:

- acquire knowledge
- develop an understanding of the strategies and concerns of the pharmaceutical industry and regulatory authorities
- interact with an industry network
- · receive recognition and support from a neutral forum, i.e. the DIA

The DIA will waive the registration fees but attendees are expected to bear their own travel and accommodation cost. On acceptance, DIA will provide further information including advice on reasonably priced accommodation, if required. The young professionals chosen will be expected to participate actively in the 24th DIA EuroMeeting and provide feedback afterwards on their experience.
